

TRASH POLICY

- (a) Refuse shall be placed in a trash can provided by the waste hauler and put at the end of the driveway no earlier than the night before trash pickup day. Anything left by the waste hauler must be returned to the garage immediately. Trash and Recycling containers should be returned to the garage by the end of the pickup day.
- (b) Pet owners who allow their pets to scatter trash may be reported to the proper authorities and may be fined by the Association. See PET POLICY
- (c) Tires, batteries, motor oil or any other item normally classified as hazardous waste shall not be placed out for pickup. The refuse company is not allowed to handle these items. The Dakota County Eco Center (The Recycling Zone) will take and dispose of these items, and others, either for free or a minimal fee. Their information can be found here:

- (d) Routine trash pickup charges are paid for from monthly maintenance assessments. Homeowner must arrange for pickup of heavy appliances, bulky furniture, mattresses, box springs, Christmas trees, etc. and pay the extra charge directly to contracted waste hauler.
